Impactful Youth Initiatives

Our Biggest Fundraiser of the Year

Literacy & Education

- **Scholarships** Awarded over **\$6,000 in scholarships** to Asbury Park High School students.
- Book Arks Working with Bridge of Books Foundation, launched Book Arks with thousands of books to high-spirited youth at several local Elementary Schools.
- Backpacks for Kids Raised money, packed and shipped hundreds of backpacks with school supplies for Community Karma initiative.

Food & Clothing Insecurities

- *Mercy Center* Volunteers keep the food pantry open in evenings to meet the needs of working families.
- Covenant House Room preparations, building renovations, landscape refreshes and birthdays celebrations are our top priorities for the male and female teen residents.

• **Mentors** - training for Club members to administer emergency services as needed and offer advice on health and nutrition.

- Second Life Bikes lots of fun is had as children run, bike and "Play on Pine" Street in Asbury Park on Friday nights. Kiwanis Club adds to the fun offering FREE snacks, drinks and activity books to all.
- Movie Afternoon at the Showroom hosted approximately 25 boys, girls and family members to a super fun afternoon full of laughs, treats, popcorn and toys!
- Beach Toy Borrow Box built and placed on 2nd Ave. for kids to "borrow " toys, enjoy for the day and return to the box for more kids. Good for the environment too -- no toys left on the beach or in the ocean.

How Much Time Will This Take?

Monthly Club Meetings (2): Business Meeting, Social Meeting

Committees: Meet as needed. Committee Chairs are expected to form and lead the committee from beginning to end of project.

Service Projects: If you actively participate in just one or two projects during the year, that's great!

We do not count service hours. Club meetings are not mandatory as minutes are issued after Club business meetings.



What Does Membership Cost?

Membership Dues: \$150/yr (prorated)

- Covers insurance
- Feeds the Kiwanis International Matching Fund
- Provides Literature, training, etc.

Background Checks (required): \$35 every 2 years

NOTE: Asbury Park Kiwanis will not allow dues to be a membership roadblock. If fees represent a challenge, the Treasurer will (discreetly) reimburse.
